NOTICE OF RACE

1. VENUE

The Expert Olympic Garda 2005 – Eurolymp will be held from 08th to 14th May 2005 on North Lake Garda – Italy. The Expert Olympic Garda 2005 is an ISAF Ranked Event and an Eurolymp Event.

2. ORGANISING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority is the Italian Sailing Federation, in conjunction with Fraglia Vela Riva, Viale G. Maroni 2, 38006 Riva del Garda, www.fragliavelariva.it - info@fragliavelariva.it and Fraglia Vela Malcesine, località Acquasana, 37018 Malcesine sul Garda.

3. ELIGIBILITY

3.1 The ISAF Eligibility Code will apply.

3.2 The Expert Olympic Garda 2005 – Eurolymp will be open to:

Laser Radial women – Laser Standard - Finn – 49er - 470 men - 470 women - Tornado – Yngling women
Star.- Neil Pryde RS-x men – Neil Pryde RS-x women

4. RULES

The event will be governed by:

- the Rules as defined in RRS 2005-2008,
- EUROLYMP Regulations,
- Any amendment to the SI
- Prescriptions of the Italian Sailing Federation will not apply.
- Appendix P – Immediate Penalties for Breaking Rule 42 shall apply, amended as follow:
- “rule P2.3 will not apply and rule P2.2 is changed so that it’ll applied to any protest after the first one”:
- for classes Tornado and 49er rules 41.1 and 42.2 are changed so that one term, including one tack and one gibe

5. ADVERTISING

5.1 The event is classified as category “C”.

5.2 The ISAF Advertising Code will apply.

5.3 Boats may be required to display a bow number and advertising stickers of the event sponsor on either side on the forward 25% of the hull. Sailboards may be required to display such number and advertising stickers on either side of the sail above the wishbone.



6. ENTRIES

- 6.1 Eligible boats may enter by completing the on-line Entry Form on the website at www.fraglivelariva.it and submitting it to the FVR. by May 1st 2005. All entries when confirmed will be displayed on the event website.
- 6.2 Entries received after May 1st 2005 will only be accepted at the discretion of the organising authority and only on the payment of an additional late entry fee of the 50% of the entry fee
- 6.3 Teams will be exempted from paying entry fees provided that they will be ranked in the top 10 of the most recent ISAF World Sailing Rankings issued before April 30th 2005.
Entries of teams ranked in the top 10 received after May 1st 2005 will be charged the ordinary entry fee

8. PAYMENT OF FEES

The above mentioned fees must be paid during completion of registrations prior to competing in the Expert Olympic Garda 2005 - Eurolymp. Only Euro currency will be acceptable.

9.COMPLETION OF REGISTRATION

9.1 Competitors shall complete on-site registration from Sunday 8th at 9.00 hrs to Monday 9th May at 19.00 hrs at the race offices of:

9.2 To register all competitors shall present to the Race Offices:

- a valid membership card to his/her MNA, if any;
- measurement Certificate and Measurement Form of the boat;
- advertising License Card of his/her MNA, if any;
- for Italian competitor: FIV membership card valid for year 2005.
- a valid insurance: each crew must hold a third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.050.000 Euros.

9.3 Sailing Instructions will be available at on-site registration.



10. SAIL NUMBERS

Boats shall use the approved Nationality Code Letters in their sails as required by RRS. In alteration of their Class Rules, their national letters on the sails shall apply for any class.

11. MEASUREMENT

From Sunday 8th at 9.00 hrs to Monday 9th May at 19.00 hrs prior to the races all sails must be checked and stamped by the Measurement Committee.

12. COURSES

There will be 5/6 course areas as shown in the Sailing Instructions.

13. COMPETITION FORMAT

The competition Format has been developed in close consultation with other World Cup Organisers and the ISAF and follows as close as possible the guidelines for Olympic Games.

All entered competitors will have the opportunity to sail until the last day of racing.

13.1 Competition with a split fleet.

Fleets may be split.

When a class is split into groups, the Class will sail qualifying rounds on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday and finals on Friday and Saturday. In the qualifying Rounds the boats will be regrouped, if possible, after each day's racing. From Friday will be established a Gold, Silver, Bronze and Emerald group. All Gold, Silver, Bronze and Emerald groups will compete on Friday and Saturday (Finals). All competitors will continue to race on Saturday.

First warning signal of the first race: Tuesday 10th May 2005 at 12.00 hrs.

For following races see Sailing Instruction and Notices.

14. SCORING SYSTEM

The Low -Point Scoring System will apply.

15. INTERNATIONAL JURY

An International Jury will be appointed with the approval of the Italian Sailing Federation.

The decisions of the International Jury shall be final.

18. SCHEDULE OF RACES AND SOCIAL EVENTS

18.1 For races scheduled from 11th to 14th May the time of the first warning signal of the day will be posted on the club house notice board by 20.00 hrs of the preceding day

18.2 Rescheduling of races may be made at the discretion of the Organizing Authority through Sailing Instruction.

Social Events' Programme will be given at on-site registration.



19. RIGHT TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in the Expert Olympic Garda - Eurolymp 2005 any competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authority and the sponsors of the Expert Olympic Garda - Eurolymp 2005 the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or film television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition for the said Expert Olympic Garda - Eurolymp 2005 in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the said Expert Olympic Garda - Eurolymp 2005 without compensation.

20. SUPPORT BOATS

20.1 Mechanically propelled boats are generally prohibited on Northern Lake Garda, however, during this Event, a special permit to use such boats may be issued by the organising authority. Support personnel having a boat, shall produce the following documents to the organising authority:- Motor registration document; motor boat's insurance boat; driver's identity document.

20.2 Each support boat shall fly a specific flag which will be supplied the Organising Authority together with the navigation permit. No other individual support boats shall be used.

21. PRIZE MONEY

21.1 The following prizes money (all in Euros) will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall places in each Olympic Class, **provided that the competitors (and not their representatives) will attend the prize giving ceremony. Prize Money will be awarded only to the classes that have a minimum of 20 entries.**

Three and two person boats:

1 st	€ 1.300,00
2 nd	€ 900,00
3 rd	€ 400,00

Single-handed and boards:

1 st	€ 900,00
2 nd	€ 500,00
3 rd	€ 300,00

22. LIABILITY

Competitors will sail under their own risk. The Organizing Authority and all the race Committees and the Jury decline any responsibility to person or goods, at sea or ashore, in consequence of participation in the competition. The competitors shall contract all insurances required to cover very risk, included that to a third party.
