NOTICE OF RACE

The Federation Francaise de Voile and the Yacht Club of Cannes are pleased to invite you to participate in the Cannes International Sailing Week from the 16th to the 19th February 2005.

1. Organising Authorities

The French Sailing Federation and the Yacht Club of Cannes.

2. Rules

The regatta will be governed by:

- 2.1 The ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing 2005/2008.
- 2.2 The prescriptions of the French Sailing Federation.
- 2.3 The current class rules.
- 2.4 The Sailing Instructions and any subsequent amendments.
- 2.5 The Notice of Regatta.

3. ISAF Classification

The regatta is an ISAF GRADE 2 ranked event for Olympic classes.

4. Eligibility and Entries

The event is open to boats of the international Finn class, conforming to the current Finn class rules. French competitors will require a current 2005 FFV licence, bearing a medical endorsement.

Entries must reach the Yacht Club of Cannes before the 14th February 2005.

Confirmation of entries will take place on the 15th February 2005 from 09.00 until 16.30 and on the 16th February 2005 from 09.00 until 12.00.

Competitors must present the following when signing on:

A valid FFV Licence with medical endorsement or a certificate of insurance for foreign competitors.

An authorisation to carry publicity, if applicable.

Foreign competitors must present a certificate of third party insurance or subscribe to a French Sailing Federation sporting licence.

Competitors must have a valid IFA sticker.

Entry Fee: 60 Euros, payable to the Yacht Club de Cannes.

The number of entries will be restricted to 100 boats

5. Advertising

The event is classed as category C

6. Measurement

All competing boats must conform to the class rules and competitors must be in possession of a current measurement certificate. Spot checks may be carried out, either on shore or on the water.

7. Program

15th February: reception and practice race at 14.30.
16th February: reception, first race at 14.00.
17th February: first race at 11.00
18th February: first race at 11.00
19th February: first race at 10.00, prize giving at approximately 17.00

8. Racing Area

Olympic triangle or "banana" courses in the East or West Cannes bays.

9. Penalties

In accordance with the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005/2008 and the 2004 class rules.

10. Scoring

Low points system will apply.
The maximum number of races to be sailed will be 9. The event will be valid if 4 races are sailed, if 5 or more races are sailed, the worst result will be discarded from the final score. The rule A 1.3 of the RRS 2005/2008 will apply.

11. Responsibilities

All competitors taking part in the regatta do so entirely at their own risk – see rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing. The decision to race – the organising authorities do not accept any responsibility in the case of damage to equipment, injuries or death within the framework of the regatta, which includes before, during the after the regatta.

12. Measurement

All competing boats must conform to the class rules.

13. Insurance

Each participating boat must be in possession of valid third part insurance or equivalent, for the event.

14. Boat Parking

Boats will be parked at the Yacht Club de Cannes.
