



**Event: The Anniversary Regatta** 

International Swedish Championship for the FINN CLASS and Swedish Championship for the TWO-CROWN CLASS

Date: 2009-08-14 to 2009-08-16

Organizers: Uppsala Kanotförening och Ekolns Segelklubb

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 Finn and 2-crown class rules will apply.
- 1.4 All boats shall in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 display advertising provided by the event organizer.

## 2. Eligibility requirements

- 2.1 Competitors shall comply with ISAF Regulation 19.
- 2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance.
- 2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 3. Entries

- 3.1 Advance entry shall be made not later than 2009-07-20 on the home page <a href="www.finnsm2009.se">www.finnsm2009.se</a> (finn) or <a href="www.esk.st">www.esk.st</a> (2-crown) or by e-mail <a href="mailto:info@finnsm2009.se">info@finnsm2009.se</a> or <a href="mailto:esk@esk.st">esk@esk.st</a> from the 1<sup>st</sup> of April.
- 3.2 The advance entry shall include the following: Your name, e-mail, sail number and club.
- 3.3 The entry fee is SEK 500 (finn) and payment shall be made to Pg 16 12 70-4. For 2-crown, the fee is SEK 400 which shall be paid to PG 14 10 41-4. Mark the payment with name, sail number and club. For later entries the fee is SEK 700. International participants are welcome to pay their entry fee cash at sight.

## 4. Registration and measurement checks

4.1 Registration must be finished at the race office not later than 2009-08-14 kl. 09.00 (finn). For 2-crown the date and time is 2009-08-15 kl. 0900. Finn class will arrive and register at UKF 2-crown class will arrive and register at ESK

- 4.2 Measurement certificate shall be presented prior to racing.
- 4.3 All sails must be measured and ready before arrival.

# **5. Sailing Instructions**

5.1 The sailing instructions will be handed out upon completion of the registration.

6.2 Eight races are scheduled. For 2-crown six races are planned.

## 8. Racing area

8.1 The racing area is set to the lake Ekoln, just outside the club houses.

### 9. The course

Windward-leeward/trapezoid course will be sailed.

Finnclass will sail a double outer-loop.

2-crown class will sail one inner-loop.

## 10. Protests and penalty systems

- 10.1 RRS Appendix P will apply.
- 10.2 The penalty with blue flag for infringement of RRS 31.1 will apply, as described in the sailing instructions.

## 11. Scoring

- 11.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

## 12. Prizes

12.1 The three best sailors will be awarded the plaquette of the Swedish Sailing Federation. Prices to every fifth sailor. Special prices will be awarded to the best sailor in the age range between 50 and 60 years and 60+. If more than 3 participants in "Finn Classic" the organizer provides honoree prizes.


#### **Directions:**

UKF is situated at the north shore of the lake Ekoln about 2 km west of the opening of the river Fyris.

Lat: N 59° 46' 59.74" Long: E 17° 37' 54.60" (WGS 84)

From Stockholm or Gävle (E4): Take the south turnoff from the high way (E4) and drive towards Uppsala/Gottsunda. Cross the river Fyris and Dag Hammarskölds väg. Follow Vårdsätravägen about 2km to sign "SKARHOLMEN" (2-crown) or another 100 m to "UKF Jollesegling" (Finn).

From Enköping (road 55): At Skärfelten, about 7 km before Uppsala, turn towards Uppsala Näs k:a, then towards Uppsala, Sunnersta/Skarholmen. Follow Vårdsätravägen about 1 km, drive to the right at sign "SKARHOLMEN" (2-crown) or another 100 m to the sign "UKF Jollesegling" (Finn).

ESK which is the base for 2-crown is situated at Skarholmen 500 m W UKF.
