1 INTRODUCTION

2 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 'Rules' as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules (RRS), except as any of these are altered by this Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions.

The International Finn Class Rules will apply.

The prescriptions of the Italian Sailing Federation will apply

The event is classified in Category "C" as per ISAF Regulation 20.

In case of conflict, the Italian version of Notice of Race and Sailing instructions shall be valid.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRIES

The regatta is open to all boats of the Finn Class with a valid measurement certificate, for helmsmen born in 1970 and before.

Italian competitors shall submit their FIV licences valid for the year 2007 with medical stamp and Class membership.

Foreign competitors shall comply with their national rules.

Preliminary registration shall be sent via internet or e-mail, stating name, sail number and yacht club.

Each competitor shall fill out and sign the entry form at the Race Office before 10.00 of the first day of sailing.

4 ENTRY FEE

Entry fee is 60 Euro.

5 SCHEDULE

A maximum of 6 (six) races shall be sailed, with no more than 3 races per day. Regatta will be valid after one race is completed.

11.00 - Briefing at Società Canottieri Ausonia

Races – The warning signal of the first race will be displayed at 12.00

Race Committee boat shall signal the intention of sailing subsequent races.

After races tasting of typical products by Valpanera.







Saturday September 4th

Races – Warning signal as per Race Committee notice Race Committee boat shall signal the intention of sailing subsequent races. Dinner at organizing Club

Sunday September 5th

Races – Warning signal as per Race Committee notice No warning signal shall be given after 16.00 on the last day of sailing Prizegiving and refreshments – after races

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be at the disposal of all competitors at the Regatta Office from 09.30 of September 3.

7 SCORING

The "Low Point" System of Appendix A will apply.

When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8 PRIZES
